- The school day is 7 hours long
- Please note that by law, students need to be in school at least 6 hours to be considered
 a FULL DAY OF ATTENDANCE.
- Students who arrive after 9:15am or receive an early dismissal before 1:45pm are marked ½ DAY OF ATTENDANCE
- Parents are encouraged to bring their child(ren) in to school before and after any appointment if possible

BEING IN ATTENDANCE FOR A FULL DAY IS BEST. HOWEVER. A HALF DAY OF ATTENDANCE IS BETTER THAN A FULL DAY OF BEING ABSENT!
